**Notification**

**Jammu; the 19<sup>th</sup> of February; 2009**

SRO:-30 - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, Samvat 2006 (Act. No. XIII of 2006), the Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

**1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:-**

- i) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Vigilance Organization (Gazetted) Service Recruitment (Qualification and Eligibility) Rules-2009.
- ii) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

**2. DEFINITIONS:-**

1. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-
  - a. "Administrative Department" means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of the services;
  - b. "Cadre" means the cadre of the services;
  - c. "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
  - d. "Head of the Department" means the major Head of the Department holding the administrative control of the organization;
  - e. "Post" means a permanent post carrying a substantive time scale sanctioned by the competent authority;
  - f. "Rules" means the Jammu and Kashmir Vigilance Organization (Gazetted) Service Recruitment (Qualification and Eligibility) Rules, 2009;
  - g. "State" means the Jammu and Kashmir State;
  - h. "Member of the Service" means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules;
  - i. "Schedule" means the Schedule (s) annexed to these rules;
  - j. "Service" means the Jammu and Kashmir Vigilance Organization (Gazetted) Service;
- 2) The words and expressions used in these rules but not defined, shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them respectively in the Jammu and Kashmir (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/ Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations.

3. **CONSTITUTION OF SERVICE:**

- 1) From the date of commencement of these rules there shall be constituted the "Jammu and Kashmir Vigilance Organization (Gazetted) Service.
- 2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding the post in a substantive capacity and is eligible for the post included in the cadre of the service.

4. **STRENGTH AND COMPOSITION OF THE SERVICE:**

- 1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time, and shall at the initial constitution of the service under the rules, be such as specified in Schedule-I:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the service for specified period as may be considered necessary from time to time.

- 2) The Government shall, at the interval of every five years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.

5. **QUALIFICATION AND METHOD OF RECRUITMENT:**

Unless otherwise provided in the schedule, the posting of officers/officials in the State Vigilance Organization shall be made by transfer on deputation basis from services/ departments as indicated in Schedule-II;

Provided that selection of the officers for posting in the Vigilance Organization shall be made by a committee comprising of the following:-

- a) Chief Secretary;
- b) Administrative Secretary Incharge Home Department;
- c) Administrative Secretary Incharge General Administration Department; and
- d) Commissioner of Vigilance.

6. **RESIDUARY MATTERS:**

In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the State Civil Service in general.

**7. INTERPRETATION:**

If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

**8. REPEAL AND SAVING:-**

- i) All rules corresponding to these rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed.
- ii) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment made; order issued or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or issued under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
