Celebration of the Constitution Day on 26th November, 2019instructions thereof.

Circular No.04-JK(GAD) of 2019 Dated:22.11.2019

26th of November has a unique significance in the history of independent India as it was on this day in 1949 that the Constitution for the Country was adopted, and, thereafter, came into force on January 26, 1950, thereby, marking the dawn of a new era.

To acknowledge the contribution of the framers of the Constitution, and sensitize the people regarding the exalted values and the precepts enshrined in it, 26th of November is being observed as the 'Constitution Day'. This year will mark the 70th Anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution. The celebrations will be marked by reading of the 'Preamble' to the Constitution in all the Institutions/Government Offices and other Establishments and launching of a National Campaign regarding a very important feature of the Constitution- the Fundamental Duties. The campaign would start from 26th of November, 2019 and culminate on 14th of April, 2020 i.e on Dr. B. R. Ambedkar's birth anniversary.

The 'Preamble' to the Constitution shall be read out in Civil Secretariat on 26th of November, 2019 at 11:00 AM followed by pledge to the Fundamental Duties. The Divisional Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Heads of the Departments and the Heads of all the Police Formations shall undertake similar activity in their respective offices and ensure that all subordinate offices also read out the 'Preamble' on Constitution Day at 11:00 AM and pledge to the fundamental duties. The copy of the 'Preamble' Fundamental Duties can be accessed at the official website of General Administration Department (GAD) i.e. www.jkgad.nic.in.

The Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs has been nominated as the Nodal Department to coordinate the activities of the Departments of School Education, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, GAD,

Higher Education, Social Welfare, Home, Housing & Urban Development, Youth Services & Sports, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Tourism and Information.

As National Campaign is to be organized from the 26th of November. 2019 upto 14th of April 2020, Administrative Secretaries, Divisional Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners (DCs), Heads of the Departments and the Heads of all the Police Formations are, therefore, advised to chalk out month wise calendar of activities to be undertaken, as part of the campaign. An indicative list of activities to be undertaken is forming Annexure to this Circular.

The soft copies/versions of IEC material such as brochures, flyers, posters, films, logo, etc. related to the campaign are available on the website of the Ministries of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India and Department of Justice, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India for downloading and further use.

All the Administrative Secretaries/Head of Departments/ DCs/ MDs/ and others Offices are impressed upon to observe the 'Constitution Day' and ensure undertaking of various activities under the National Campaign in a befitting manner.

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ¹[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens:

Je '[Part IV-A ♣ FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

ARTICLE 51-A. Fundamental duties.—It shall be the duty of every citizen of India—

- (a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural envirountent including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- (i) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
