Subject: Compassionate appointment of Mr. Kewal Sharma S/o Late Bodh Raj, R/o Parwah, Tehsil Marh, District Jammu, under SRO-43 of 1994.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the temporary appointment of Mr. Kewal Sharma S/o Late Bodh Raj, (Ex-ALM, Jal Shakti Department), R/o Parwah, Tehsil Marh, District Jammu as Class-IV/MTS, in the Pay Level SL-1 (14800-47100), District Cadre Jammu in the Directorate of Family Welfare MCH&I, Health & Medical Education Department, under SRO-43 of 1994.

The appointee shall report to the Director, Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K, within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this order, failing which he shall forego his right to appointment and the same shall be deemed to have been cancelled *ab-initio* without any further notice.

The appointee shall be allowed to join only on the production of the following certificates (in original) to be verified subsequently: -

- i. Academic Qualification Certificate.
- ii. Date of Birth Certificate.
- iii. Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District.
- iv. Domicile Certificate.
- v. All other relevant documents as are required under SRO-43/1994.

The appointment of the appointee shall further be subject to the following conditions:-

- a. That he shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit to the effect that if on verification, his Qualification/Date of Birth/ Category Certificates if any, from the concerned issuing authority are found to be fake/forged, the claim of the appointee for appointment as Class-IV/MTS shall be deemed to have been cancelled *ab-initio* and legal action as warranted under rules shall be initiated against him.
- b. That he shall give an undertaking in the shape of an Affidavit duly attested by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, to the effect that the applicant is unemployed as on date and none of the family member other than the applicant has taken benefit of compassionate appointment under SRO-43. In case it turns out that the applicant is already appointed or the benefit of compassionate appointment under SRO-43 of 1994 has been already extended to the family of the deceased, then the instant appointment shall be deemed to have been withdrawn *ab-initio* without any further notice.
- c. That if the candidate has taken loan for self employment from DIC/Employment Department, to be ascertained from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment & Counseling Centre of



the domicile District, he shall relinquish the proprietorship of unit/enterprise and also stakes, if any, in such self-employment unit/enterprise before joining the Government service. He shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his salary. DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such a self-employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and also personally monitor its recovery.

- d. The salary of the appointee shall not be drawn and disbursed to him unless a satisfactory report in respect of genuineness of Qualification/Date of Birth/Category Certificate, if any, is received from the concerned Authorities.
- e. The appointee shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- f. The appointment of the candidate shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
- g. The appointment of the above appointee shall be subject to outcome of writ petition(s), if any, pending before Competent Court of law.
