Terms of reference:

- i. To review the existing institutional mechanisms and recommend steps to be adopted to implement a whole-of-government approach for improved inter-departmental coordination in planning, implementation and monitoring of initiatives impacting citizens' ease of living.
- ii. To identify interventions required to enhance ease of living for citizens, including simplification of procedures, reduction of compliance burden, and improved access to public services.
- iii. To examine existing processes and recommend steps for effective streamlining, convergence and elimination of redundancies to ensure seamless citizen-centric governance.
- iv. To suggest measures for integration of digital platforms, data sharing and institutional coordination across departments.
- v. To recommend a roadmap for adoption of whole-of-government framework aimed at improving ease of living outcomes for citizens.
