The Member-Convener shall coordinate with all the members of the Committee for timely convening of meeting(s) and to ensure timely appraisal/vetting of document(s).

Terms of Reference:

- i. To examine and vet the Detailed Project Report (DPR) procured/proposed for the project in a comprehensive manner, covering technical, financial, administrative, legal and operational aspects.
- ii. To assess whether the objectives, scope, deliverables, timelines and outcomes proposed in the DPR are clearly defined, realistic and aligned with the approved policy framework and project requirements.

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- iii. To scrutinize the technical architecture, specifications, design parameters, standards, interoperability, scalability, security provisions and sustainability aspects proposed in the DPR, ensuring adherence to prevailing Government standards.
- iv. To ensure strict compliance to all the rules, procedure(s)/guidelines issued by Government from time to time, while submitting the recommendations.

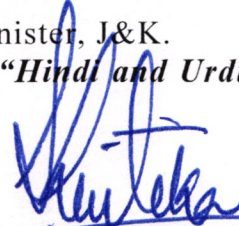
